I, **Hillary Hebert**, do declare as follows:

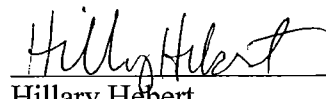

Code § 6254(k) and/or specific provisions of General Order ("GO") 66-C.

3. In accordance with the legal authority described herein, the Protected Information should be protected from public disclosure.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
